## Financial Policy

Peninsula Adventist School uses Smart Tuition to collect tuition on a monthly basis. It is expected that our student's accounts will be kept current. In the event that a student's account is not kept current, the following steps will be taken:

1. A notice will be sent as a reminder which will give you 10 days to bring your account current.
2. If your account is not brought current, your child(ren) will be put on economic suspension.
3. To get your child(ren) back into school, you may do one of the following:
  - a. Pay the outstanding balance of your account
  - b. Meeting with the finance committee to present a plan to bring your account current.

If your account depends on financial aid, please remember that in order to receive the aid, you must do the following:

1. You must pay your portion of your account on time
2. Your child(ren) must receive no grade lower than 70% (C-)

Not only will your financial aid be withheld, but the following privileges will also be withheld:

1. Participation in field trips for which there is an additional fee
2. Participation in graduation services
3. Participation in after-school activities that are sponsored by the school and for which there is an additional fee.
4. Any school sponsored activity for which there are additional fees
